is a Voice Specialist Speech and Language Therapist. She was a founder member of the Sidcup Voice Clinic, together with Laryngologist, Tom Harris, Voice Specialist Osteopath, Jacob Lieberman and singer and Singing Teacher, Dinah Harris. The Sidcup Voice Clinic closed in 2009 to become the Lewisham Voice Disorders Unit which continues as a flourishing multidisciplinary centre for the treatment of voice disorders.

Sara was a co-founder of the Voice Research Society (now the British Voice Association) and a joint editor of *The Voice Clinic Handbook* in 1998. Her updated chapter on the treatment of voice disorders for second edition of the *Voice Clinic Handbook* was published in 2018. She has been an

Associate member of CoMeT since the early 1990's.

Sara retired from her Sidcup NHS post in 2010 but continued to work at the Lewisham Voice Disorders Unit running weekly clinics with Laryngologist Nick Gibbins and a busy private practice specialising in singers/performers. She regularly worked collaboratively with singing teacher and rehabilitation coach, Linda Hutchison.

Sara retired from clinical practice in 2018 but continues to do some supervision work and lecturing and maintains her links with the Lewisham Voice Disorders Unit and the British Voice Association.
