Allan Vurma, PhD, is a professor at the *Estonian Academy of Music and Theatre* where he teaches the courses on vocal methodology, acoustics, and hearing psychology. The background of his proficiency also includes electronic engineering and classical singing. He has been for several decades the soloist of the professional *Estonian Philharmonic Chamber Choir*. Allan Vurma has won high prizes from some National and International singing competitions, performed some opera roles and given solo recitals. He is the national coordinator of the *World-Voice-Day* in Estonia and the member of the editorial board of the journal *Musicae Scientiae*. Last few decades he has united his competency in singing and engineering by conducting several research projects on the singing voice and its perception. He is the Co-Chair of the 14th *Pan European Voice Conference* in Tallinn ESTONIA.
